LEADING AND MANAGING IN THE DIGITAL ERA: SHAPING THE FUTURE OF WORK AND BUSINESS EDUCATION

Digital technologies, such as the internet of things (IoT), artificial intelligence (AI), machine learning, robotics, blockchain, and virtual and augmented reality are leaving a lasting impact on the way we work, live, and communicate. These rapidly emerging technologies are radically transforming areas of cognitive and physical work, enhancing efficiency, and opening new opportunities and new challenges. As a result, management roles are evolving in constantly renewed directions. In this digital era, managers work alongside intelligent machines that perform many cognitive tasks hitherto performed exclusively by humans. Academic and industry leaders need to work together to debate and exploit the potential of digital technologies today and shape the future of work and business education to foster digital and leadership skills in preparation for future challenges.

A NEW STYLE OF LEADERSHIP IS REQUIRED

where digital savviness is essential, together with an increased focus on collaboration, transparency, entrepreneurship, diversity, and inclusion. Additionally, as the development of digital technologies converges with the trajectories of deepening environmental problems and increasing sociopolitical turbulence, risk awareness and risk management become top priorities. This results in new ethical challenges as business needs to pursue sustainability and responsibility. Decision-makers here often find themselves in uncharted waters, making stronger collaboration of industry and academia imperative.

A UNIQUE CONFERENCE

This conference is unique in that it will bring together academic leaders, academic researchers, and industry leaders to discuss new results on management and leadership in the digital era, as well the impact of digital on business and on education. The conference will feature selected papers presenting innovative research results and their business impact, as well as discussion papers and panels by academic leaders and industry leaders on their vision about the future of Business Schools and business education in view of the opportunities in the digital era. AN INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE IN ATHENS, JUNE 19-20, 2023

The conference is jointly organized by the Athens University of Economics and Business, Stevens Institute of Technology, and the Bodossaki Foundation and will take place in Athens, Greece on June 19-20, 2023. There will be an official dinner on the evening of June 19th. The conference will take place at the Divani Palace Acropolis hotel. This 5-star hotel is just minutes away from the Acropolis Museum and the center of Athens. Early reservation is advisable to take advantage of special prices for the conference participants.

RESEARCH COLLOQUIUM AND DOCTORAL CONSORTIUM IN SYROS, JUNE 21-23, 2023

An academic extension of the conference is being planned for June 21-23, 2023, on the island of Syros, where participants will have the opportunity to participate in invited research workshops, presentations of major funded research projects, networking and discussions about collaborations in funded research, and participation in a Doctoral consortium. The sessions will take place at the Hermes hotel, overlooking the deep blue water of the Aegean Sea on one side and the historic city center at the background. More details will be announced in early 2023.

CONFERENCE PROCEEDINGS & VOLUME BY SPRINGER

There will be two outlets of the proceedings of this conference. The extended abstracts of all presented papers will be published in an eBook with an ISBN number. Additionally, selected full papers will appear in a volume to be published by Springer.

SUBMISSIONS

The conference solicits research and opinion papers in English. Authors of papers are invited to submit to **EasyChair** (<https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=lmde2023>) an extended abstract (800-1.500 words) of their paper for peer review by February 1, 2023. Authors will be notified about the acceptance for presentation of their paper at the conference by February 28, 2023. Authors of accepted abstracts will be offered the opportunity of publishing their full paper in an edited volume published by Springer. Such papers should be submitted by May 30, 2023 and will be subject to a peer-review process. Guidelines for the papers to be published in the Springer volume will be available on the conference website soon. Authors interested in having their papers published in the Springer volume should indicate so upon submission of the extended abstract. Additionally, the conference accepts proposals for panel roundtables, presentations of funded research projects and doctoral research. Further submission guidelines for these proposals will be published on the conference web site. All accepted abstracts will be published in an eBook with an ISBN number. Extended summaries of research colloquium presentations may also be published in the Springer volume after review.

REGISTRATION FEE

The conference registration fee is **€450**. The reduced early bird registration fee is **€375** until **March 30, 2023**. Doctoral students may participate at a reduced fee. An additional **€150** registration is required for participation in the research colloquium and doctoral consortium. **The reduced early bird registration fee for the Syros extension is €120 until March 30, 2023.
